The Centre for Medical Education in the Faculty of Medicine at McGill University invites applications for the Director of the newly created Assessment and Evaluation Unit. McGill University has recently created an interprofessional assessment and evaluation unit for all health professions to ensure learner assessment, program evaluation, capacity building, and research and scholarship.

Position:

The successful candidate will help to develop and implement the vision for a new interprofessional assessment and evaluation unit; will provide leadership and guidance in the development and implementation of learner and faculty assessment and program evaluation in the Faculty of Medicine; will collaborate closely with the Associate Deans of the health professions education programs and the members of the Centre for Medical Education, as well as Teaching and Learning Services and the Faculty of Education, in the development of new initiatives and priorities for this unit; will coach and supervise the unit's staff to implement best practices in assessment and evaluation; and will promote capacity building and a scholarly agenda for the Unit, including research, peer-reviewed publications and dissemination of findings. The successful candidate will also be expected to conduct high-quality research, publish in peer-reviewed journals, and engage with the community of educational researchers at the Centre for Medical Education.

The successful applicant will hold a Contract Academic Staff appointment in the Faculty of Medicine. This position is full-time, and is a three-year renewable appointment at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor. The salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Education/Experience:

The successful candidate must hold a PhD degree (in a health-related field, in education, or in a related field such as psychology or another social science) and/or a degree in the health professions, with relevant experience in assessment, evaluation, administration and educational research. Knowledge of assessment methods and theory, as well as quantitative and qualitative methodologies is required, as is a track record of research in this field. This position also requires strong communication skills, collaborative leadership and strong management skills.
